Please note:

Morris sides and amplified music

Please remember that you can only use amplified music to accompany Morris Dancing where you are on/at premises or events covered by a Public Entertainments Licence, or a Temporary Events Notice. The onus is on YOU to check that the event organisers have the appropriate licence/notice in place should you wish to use amplification.

Morris is normally exempt from the Provisions of the Licensing Act **only when using unamplified music**. Using amplified music without a licence is illegal and thus may invalidate your insurance.

Mummers

Mummers' plays, where not part and parcel of a Morris performance, are also NOT exempt from the Public Entertainment Licence regulations, ie you need either to be performing at a venue which has a PEL, or to take out a Temporary Events Notice for each of the venues at which you will be performing. The onus is on YOU to check that the event organisers have the appropriate licence/notice in place. Otherwise you are acting illegally and thus you may invalidate your insurance.

The implications of this are that, should you then cause any damage or injury (that would have been claimable through the Public Liability Insurance), the Officers of your side may become jointly and personally responsible for the ensuing costs.

Disclosure of information

We supply a Members' Address List to member sides and individual members which includes postal address, phone no, email and website addresses. Open Morris does not normally pass on this list to outside bodies. However, they can of course obtain information publicly available on the website. The Open Morris website lists only a contact name, phone no and email, plus brief details of what each side dances and practice details.
